

SAND CEREMONY

WHAT IS IT?

A sand ceremony is a ritual symbolising the joining of two individuals, the merging of two families and in some cases, the creation of a blended family.

WHAT HAPPENS DURING A SAND CEREMONY?

This all depends on who/how many participants are included in the ceremony. The ceremony will require a bottle of coloured sand for each participant (different colour for each person) and one larger bottle that the sand will be tipped into – "blending" the couple/family into a new family.

ONLY THE COUPLE PARTICIPATE

- 1. Your celebrant will introduce the ritual, explaining the significance and setting the scene for what is to come
- 2. Your celebrant will invite you, the couple, to each tip your sand into the large bottle, blending to two individual colours
- 3. Your celebrant will say a few more words to finalise the sand ceremony

A sand ceremony is a lovely way to include other family members, particularly children. If including children, step 2 above will include additional bottles of coloured sand that the children will also tip into the large bottle, symbolising the blending of all individuals into a new family.
